

1928 - The Unit continued to Install officers at other towns. 291 quarts of fruit, 17 quarts of jelly and 20 glasses of jam were sent to Hospitals in Battle Creek. \$5.00 worth of tooth paste, razor blades and shaving cream, and shoe strings were sent to Mrs Alta Smithle at Battle Creek, who is Rehabilitation Chariman. Mrs Monica Sinkule donated silverware to the Auxiliary and pains were made to purchase much needed dishes. New by-laws were written and discussed - there accepted as written. District 4 meeting was held in South Haven in June. District dues of 10¢ per member were paid. \$10.00 was sent to Rehabilitation Chairman at Battle Creek to purchase pajamas for the veterans. \$15.00 each was allowed for two delegates to State Convention held at Petosky. Three barrels of clothing and one large box of blankets and shoes were sent thru the Red Cross for the Florida Flood Relief. Pajamas, bathrobes and bedroom slippers were sent to Camp Custer Hospital. \$15.00 was sent to Department for National Convention fund. Gold Star members would have their dues paid by the Unit. in the future. 230 quarts of fruit and 77 glasses of jellies were sent to the Hospital at Battle Creek.
