

1930- One Hundred and nine quarts of canned fruit and 26 glasses of jelly were taken to Hospital at Camp Custer. Subscriptions to two popular magazines, Good Housekeeping and Better Homes and Gardens - were being solicited to earn money for Unit. Unit was assessed \$10.00 for Ethel Nieman Scholarship fund. Valentines were sent to boys at Camp Custer. The 10¢ per capita for rehabilitation was brought up and voted paid. Clothing was collected for the Childrens Billet and wash clothes, towels and dreccerscarfs were sent to Camp Custer. Easter cards, bud vases and money sent to the Hbospital for Easter and Mothers Day programs. Members conducted parties at their homes to earn money for Unit. Christmas cards were purchased for cashle. Unit decided to have first meeting of every month as a card party, charging 25¢ to members and 50¢ to non members. \$10.00 was given to the City Releif Fund for Christmas.
