

1933- Mable Wenban elected President. Five dollars for Service basket and \$5.00 for Childrens Billet was forwarded from Unit. Canned 100 quarts of fruit taken to Camp Custer. Campfire Girls gave a Silver Tea and program for Unit members and their daughters. Arm bands were made for members. Eight pairs of Curtains were made for the Billet. Meetings were not too well attended and many were held at members homes. Campfire Girls again helped sell poppies. Sales slips from the local drug stores were saved and used as credit for the Service basket articles. Convention Fund of \$20.00 was paid to Department under protest. Unit reached quota of 55 members. Each member donated 5 handkerchiefs for Children at Billet. Fines of 5¢ were placed on members not wearing Auxiliary pins. Fine money put in Banner Fund. \$5.00 each was sent to the Billet and American Legion Hospital for Christmas. 112 quarts of canned fruit and 20 jars of jelly were divided between the Billet and Camp Custer.
