

1934- Ermay Shoop elected President. Diapers and layettes were made for the Red Cross. A dance was held at the Janis Hotel cost 50¢ a couple and Unit profitted \$1.80. Candy was given to the men of the community who are patients of American Legion Hospital. Unit held a dance to earn money for Campfire Girls. District Committee woman, W. Helma Webster was guest of Unit with program and refreshments after the meeting. The G. A. R. Hall was again offered to the Unit but was declined. Meetings were held in local real estate offices of R. H. Clarke. Unit endorsed Mrs Bernice Clarke for District Alternate Committee woman. Baked Sale netted \$11.21 toward Banner Fund. Penny Marches were continued at meetings. Scholarship medals were given to High School students. Canning Committee visited local Michigan Fruit Canners to get prices on canned fruit. Mr William McErving President, donated 6 cases (144 qts), 4 cases shipped to Billet and 2 cases to American Legion Hospital. Ninety glasses of jelly was divided between the Emanuel Home (aged people hospital) and the American Legion Hospital. Aprons were made and sold for Banner fund. Many families in city in distress and Unit voted to help whenever possible.
