

1935- Eunice Hinz elected President. A joint meeting of Auxiliary and Post was held and 52 persons were in attendance. Excess food from the Pot-Luck dinner auctioned off and \$5.35 was realized for the Units Treasury. Six bushels were given to needy families - each containing staples - fruits, vegetables, candy, nuts and some toys and clothing. Quilt blocks were sewn to make a patch work quilt to be raffled off, at a profit of \$7.35. Card Parties were held at close of meetings. 5 Sheets were purchased from quilt fund for Childrens Billet. Sweaters, stockings and handkies were also sent to Billet. A gingham dance was held at Dixie Inn to aid the Banner fund. The American Legion sponsored a Beauty Contest July 4th and ladies of the Unit were asked to help. Banners were purchased and Insured. Diapers and layettes were made for Red Cross. Banners were dedicated. Flag holders were donated by husband of President, Eunice Hinz. Eighteen flowers vases were given to two local hospitals. Childrens clothing and 4 cases of canned goods was sent to Billet and a like amount sent to Legion Hospital. The Legion has a Home and invited the Auxiliary to use the Hall for their meetings and other gatherings. The invitation was graciously accepted. First meeting held December 3, 1935. Post members greeted the Auxiliary and stated we were free to use Hall when we desired as long as no conflict with Legion's use.
