Ways and Means were devised to raise money for Building fund. Bridge party and dances were held to aid the fund. 6 bushel baskets were filled for community. Christmas, letter written by 6 year old girl to Santa Claus at Billet was read and Unit filled her request for doll, doll house, sewing set and toy piano. Gift raffle and magazine subscriptions helped swell the Building fund. Pot Luck dinners were held honoring Gold Star Members and Post. Books were donated to local Library. Recipes were sold to each other and Legion held Fish Fries to earn money for Post Home. Dresses for size 6 were sewn for Billet. Silverware purchased and Unit pledged \$200.00 to Post to help pay off indebtedness. Bernice Clarke was endorsed for District Committeewoman. A picnic supper and dance netted \$1.21 for Building fund. Newspaper and magazines were sent to patients of 2nd Army in local Hospital. Five Dollars was sent to Soldiers Home in Grand Rapids for the Stamp fund. Unit voted to pay for half of circulation heater for Post Home. Red Cross sewing continued and canned goods sent to both Billet and Legion Hospital. Baskets at Christmas were limited to veterans only.
