

1937- Bessie Kiethly , President. Funds were sent to Billet for coats for youngsters housed there. Unit worked packing clothing - food for Flood Relief. Bath towels and wash cloths were sent to Billet along with curtains the members had sewn. We collected used silk stockings for Camp Custer. Knox Jell box tops were collected in lots of 100 - one cent each was given to the Unit. Gingham dance was held and proceeds used to send Twin Cities Drum and Bugle Corps to National Convention. Poppies were displayed at McKimmies store. Legion Post sponsored a beach picnic for the Peach Festival and ladies assisted them. \$100.00 was pledged to Post for mortgage retirement fund. District dinners were 65¢ at this time. Money was sent to Hospital and Billet for canned goods. Masquarade dance held on Holloween eve and \$3.00 was the profit from dance. Dishes were purchased for Post Home and were used for Legions Venison Supper - Post and Auxiliary went together on filling baskets for needy veterans for Christmas. Billet needs snow suits - \$6.00 sent by Unit along with toys for children housed at Billet. Canned foods were brought to Christmas pot luck supper. These to be put in local Relief baskets - There were seven baskets filled. Mrs Arthur Clarke Sr. was elected District President.
