

1940- A Valentines party was planned and a Chop suey supper was enjoyed by all, with a dance held afterwards. Unit invited the District President, Mrs Arnold to meet with them in February. Voted to keep dues at \$2.00 per year. Blankets were purchased for a needy family and 2 tablecloths sent to Billet. The balance of mortgage on Post Home is \$400.00. Legion and Auxiliary prepare for big 4th of July carnival to pay off mortgage. Unit sends a boy to Boy's State, cost of \$15.00. Unit entertained Campfire Girls at sponsors Unit invited 9 members for Bangor Unit. A dance was held for sons of Legion members and daughters of Auxiliary members. Orchestra for dance charged \$6.00 for the night and the affair was well attended. The total cost of the party was \$12.55 Unit planned to help Legion with the Sons of the Legion; \$6.00 was donated to them. Wreaths were made for deceased members for Memorial Day. Campfire Girls were paid \$7.00 for their help in selling poppies. Waldemar Radthke, boys state delegate gave the Unit a very interesting talk on his stay at Boys State. Talk about starting a Junior Auxiliary at this time. Elections of officers was held and Mrs Pearl Lemke was re-elected as President. Unit accepted offer of Legion, to receive 25% of profits of Carnival to be held during Peach festival. A net profit to the Legion was \$123.00 and the Unit share was \$30.82. Many new committees

were added to list of appointees. A halloween dance was held and a profit of \$5.00 was realized. \$10.00 was donated to Widows and Orphan of Fisherman who perished in a bad storm on Lake Michigan Near South Haven, Four baskets of fruit taken to Camp Custer for Christmas.
