A Baked Bean supper was held for the Posts Birthday Party. Dawn Maybie and Mary Tromp were the two girls selected to go to Girls State, one from Legion, and one from Kawanis. Miss Edna Boyce of Saugatuck was elected District President. Unit voted to send \$5.00 to China Relief Fund. \$1.00 donated to Campfire Girls toward sending girl to Camp. Members canvassed town for unemployment service - members were asked to earn \$1.00 each for Unit. Twenty members attended a Flag Day Ceremony in City Park with the Unit colors being presented at the ceremonies. Pot-luck suppers - magazines subscriptions and card parties continued to be ways of earning money for Auxiliary. Mrs Mable Wenban elected President of Unit. A used record collection was held throughout the city. The records to go to U. S. O. Centers. Unit sponsored a booth at Peach Festival, to sell war bonds and stamps. They sold \$825.00 worth of bonds and \$110.00 worth of stamps. Army and Navy Mothers Auxiliary met with Unit to tell of their purposes. Armistice Day Banquet held in Congregational Church Hall. Unit cut and served 55 pairs of pajamas for Red Cross as well as donating money for their other programs. Unit and Post met the same evening, to save transportation,

lights, and heat costs. The Unit gave \$5.00 to Good-fellow Fund to help needy of our town at Christmas, also played Santa Claus for 1 child at Billet. Five dollars sent for fruit for Billet.
