

1947- Rules were given for Doll dressing contest for Columbia the Pan-American country. Two members were appointed to work with Legion on "Clarke for Department Commander". Donations were made to Chapel Fund at Grand Rapids, to the Cigarette Fund for Hospitals and to the Red Cross. Pan-American day was observed, with all Patriotic organizations and Benton Harbor Auxiliary attending. Diapers were made and sent to the Billet. Clothing was collected for Ministerial Association, for relief abroad. Jean Vitek was chosen to attend Girls State. 2500 poppies were sold with a net profit of \$251.12. New Post Commander is a W.W. II Veteran and a V.J. Day Program was a huge success. New dishes were purchased for Post Home. \$75.00 sent for Operating Table Fund at Fort Custer. Mrs Gordon elected as President of Unit. \$30.00 worth of Gifts were sent to Gift Shop at V.A. Hospital at Dearborn. Mr. Arthur Clarke Sr. Elected Department of Mich. Commander.
