Largest poppy sale ever, sold 1889 of 2,00, the Unit purchased. Members of Unit and Post took part in Flag Day Program sponsored by the Elks Club. A fish fry was held for the 40/8 Club. Florence Rogel elected President of ^{4th District} ~~Unit #49~~. Dues were raised to \$3.00 per year per member and pins for new members be included, at this price. Post and Auxiliary held a picnic at Sleepy Hollow Beach. Rummage sales, fish fries and spaghetti suppers helped swell the Treasury. Mandatory funds of \$105.00 were paid.
