It sounds like things are a little interesting down there in South Haven. Larry said that he was going to review and hopefully approve the revised wall by the end of this week – once that is done I will fill out the right-of-way permit application and the soil erosion permit application for submittal. Once we get final approval from the building department, whoever that ends up being, I would think that deBest could begin doing clearing work – just no root / stump removal until we get the soil erosion permit.
